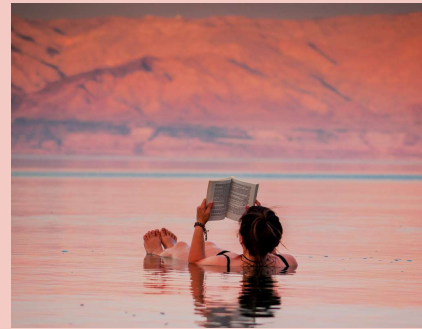

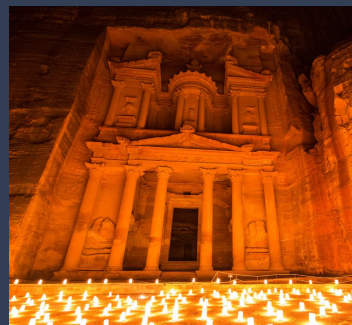

# Best of Jordan Tour Itinerary

## Day 1: 9 November 25 – Amman

Arrival in Amman. Welcome to Jordan!

Upon arrival at Queen Alia International Airport, you will be warmly greeted assisted with custom and immigration formalities. Transfer to your hotel in Amman, the capital city. Relax and settle in as you prepare for an exciting journey ahead.

## Day 2: 10 November - Amman Special City Tour

Start your day with a visit to the King Abdullah Mosque, known for its striking blue dome and as a memorial to the late King Abdullah the first. Continue to the heart of the city with a visit to the ruins of the Amman Roman Theatre, an impressive 2nd-century structure, and explore the ancient Citadel and Umayyad Palace. Take a short walk through the souks and markets before immersing yourself in history at the Jordan Museum. Wander through Rainbow Street, Amman's cultural gem, full of charming cafes and antique shops.

## Day 3: 11 November - Amman, Ajlun & Jerash (160km)

Explore the Ajlun Castle, an 12th-century fortress with sweeping views of the Jordan Valley. Next, visit Jerash, the "City of a Thousand Columns," one of the best-preserved Roman cities in the world. Walk down its grand colonnaded streets and admire its ancient temples, theaters, and fountains. Return to the hotel in Amman for a free evening at leisure

## Day 4: 12 November - Amman to the Dead Sea (50km)

Today, we journey to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Known for its healing properties, the Dead Sea offers a unique experience where you can float effortlessly in the warm, salty waters and indulge in mineral-rich mud treatments.

## Day 5: 13 November - Dead Sea Leisure Day

Take a full day to relax and rejuvenate in the tranquil surroundings of the Dead Sea. Enjoy the therapeutic mud that is renowned for its medicinal benefits or simply float in the buoyant waters.

## Day 6: 14 November - Dead Sea, Madaba, Mount Nebo, Shobak & Petra (350km)

Travel along the historic King's Highway, an ancient route that dates back to Biblical times. Visit Madaba, known as the "City of Mosaics," and see the 6th-century mosaic map of the Holy Land at St. George Church.

Continue to Mount Nebo, where Moses is said to have seen the Promised Land before he passed away.

Discover the remains of the ancient Shobak Castle, a Crusader stronghold. Finally, head to Petra, the "Rose-Red City," where you'll be enchanted by the beauty of the ancient Nabatean ruins.

## Day 7: 15 November - Petra Exploration

Today is dedicated to exploring the magnificent Petra, one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. Begin your adventure with a horse ride through the Siq, a narrow, winding gorge, which opens up to reveal the stunning Treasury, Petra's most famous monument. As you wander through the ancient city, marvel at the intricate tombs, temples, and monuments carved into the rose-hued cliffs.

## Day 8: 16 November - Petra & Wadi Rum (120km)

Return to Petra for a second visit at your own leisure, giving you the opportunity to explore more of its hidden gems. Then, continue south to Wadi Rum, a vast desert known for its dramatic sandstone mountains and ancient petroglyphs. Hop on a 4x4 Bedouin Jeep tour for a thrilling ride through the stunning desert landscape. Experience the silence and beauty of the desert before heading to your desert camp.

## Day 9: 17 November - Wadi Rum to Aqaba

After breakfast, head to Aqaba, Jordan's charming coastal city on the Red Sea. Aqaba is famous for its beautiful beaches, luxury resorts, and warm, clear waters. Spend your day at leisure, enjoying the sun, sand, and water sports like windsurfing or diving in the world-renowned coral reefs.

## Day 10: 18 November - Aqaba
