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19 SEP: ARRIVE NAIROBI

Depart Brisbane on your flight to Nairobi.

20 SEP: ARRIVE NAIROBI

On arrival, you will be met and transferred to the hotel. Relax and enjoy your first day at leisure with the opportunity to meet your fellow travellers while enjoying dinner at the hotel. *Four Points by Sheraton Nairobi Airport (D)*

21/22 SEP: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK - LAND OF GIANTS

After breakfast, your safari kicks into gear as you journey south to the legendary Amboseli National Park. Famed for its unrivalled views of Mt. Kilimanjaro, Africa's tallest peak, Amboseli is a place where the landscapes are as iconic as the wildlife. Enjoy your first game drive, spotting wildlife against the dramatic backdrop of snow-capped Kilimanjaro. Keep your camera ready for Amboseli's famous large elephant herds, often seen wandering gracefully across the plains. Amboseli Sopa Lodge - 2 nights (BLD)

23/24 SEP: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast and checkout. Today you will transfer over the border from Kenya to Tanzania where you will be assisted with any border formalities. Continue on to Arusha where you stop to enjoy lunch. Afterwards you proceed to Tarangire National Park for a 2-night stay at Tarangire Kati Kati including all meals. Spend your time here exploring the park on game drives with your driver guide. *Tarangire Kati Kati - 2 nights (BLD)*

25 SEP: NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

Set off for Karatu, a charming town on the edge of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The drive takes you through the heart of Tanzania's stunning landscapes, with rolling hills, vibrant coffee plantations, and glimpses of local village life. This journey offers a fantastic opportunity to witness the diverse scenery and get a sense of the country's rich agricultural heritage. Visit Mto Wa Village for a tour followed by lunch at Gibbs Farm then continue on to your lodge. *Ngorongoro Forest Tented Lodge (BLD)*.

26 SEP: NGORONGORO CRATER

Rise early for an unforgettable safari in the Ngorongoro Crater, one of Africa's most iconic natural wonders. Head towards the crater, descending into this vast, caldera-shaped sanctuary that is home to an incredible diversity of wildlife. As you explore the crater floor, you'll have the chance to spot the "Big Five" – lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard and rhinoceros – along with a myriad of other animals such as zebra, wildebeest and flamingos. Your expert guide will provide fascinating insights into the area's geology, ecology, and history, enhancing your understanding of this unique ecosystem. Ascend the Crater in the afternoon and continue to your Masai Boma experience. *Ngorongoro Forest Tented Lodge (BLD)*

27/28/29 SEP: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy breakfast before checking out and meeting your driver guide. Today you drive to Serengeti National Park via a stop at Olduvai Gorge, a site of great archaeological significance where early human fossils were discovered. Proceed on your drive, arriving at Tukaone Weavers Camp in time to check-in for your 3-night stay including all meals. Spend your time here exploring the Serengeti on game drives with your driver guide.

Tukaone Weavers Camp - 3 nights (BLD)

30 SEP/1/2 OCT: THE MASAI MARA

Enjoy breakfast at the camp then our driver guide will transfer us by road to the Tanzania / Kenya Sirari border post (Isebania) for Customs and Immigration formalities before continuing by road to the Masai Mara.

On arrival at our camp, check in for 3 nights. The Masai Mara is known for its spectacular wildlife and large numbers of elephants, lions, rhino, buffalo, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and more.

Zebra Plains Mara Camp is located below Oldonyo Oloip Ridge, home to the Moniko Pride of lions, and with best views of the open plains of the Mara frequented by giraffes, zebras, impalas, topis, buffalos and many other plain game. There is also a waterhole infront of the camp that gets busy during dry season. During our stay, enjoy game drives throughout the reserve with the chance to view the annual migration (subject to climatic conditions). Zebra Plains Mara Camp - 3 nights (BLD)

3/4 OCT: LAKE NAKURU

Checkout and drive to Lake Nakuru for 2 nights at Ziwa Bush Lodge. Arrive in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park. Located on the floor of the Kenyan Great Rift Valley system, this fracture in the earth's crust stretches around 6,500 km from The Middle East to Southern Africa. During our stay enjoy game drives around the lake shore - home to a good population of rhino. The following day, enjoy a visit to Hells Gate National Park and Elsmere Lodge & Museum for lunch. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight *Ziwa Bush Lodge - 2 nights (BLD)*

5 OCT: RETURN TO NAIROBI

Journey back to Nairobi Airport, where we will board our evening flight to Australia. (*B*)

6 OCT: ARRIVE

Arrive back in Brisbane where our East Africa Adventure ends.
